Artist Statement

I am a watercolor artist. I believe no medium works better than watercolor for expressing the beauty of the natural world. It's transparency and the way that pigment mixes and moves in the water gives the medium its own voice in addition to the intent of the artist. Nature is my primary subject matter, be it a landscape, wildflowers or an intimate close-up of the natural world. It is from nature that my creative energy flows. My hope is that viewers of my art feel my connection to nature when they see my art.

Artist Biography

Artist and graphic designer, Chris Sommerfelt discovered watercolor at an adult evening class in the early 1980s and has since been intrigued with what happens when you mix pigment and water. Chris has since studied with Bridget Austin, Win Jones, Joye Moon, Tom Francesconi, Sharon Crosbie, Ann Miotke and Alice Struck. All of these artists have influenced Chris along her artistic journey, and she thanks them.

Chris has work in private collections as well as twelve pieces in the corporate collection of Northwestern Mutual Life.

Chris currently teaches watercolor at the Hart Park Senior Center and the Wauwatosa Recreation Department. She has taught classes at the UW-Waukesha extension and at Lakes Gallery in North Lake, WI. In addition, Chris teaches a week-long watercolor workshop at The Clearing in Door County as well as two-day workshops. Chris has been asked to conduct critiques, demos, and judge exhibits for local art groups. She is member of the League of Milwaukee Artists, exhibits chair for Wisconsin Watercolor Society, and mentor for the Wauwatosa Artist's Workshop. Chris has received numerous merit awards at Wauwatosa Artist Workshop art exhibits in southeastern Wisconsin. She was an award winner in the statewide 2014 juried "Alive in the Arts" exhibit at the Plymouth Art Center.

In addition to her watercolors, Chris is an accomplished fiber artist who has received local and national recognition for her art quilts and has had two solo exhibits featuring those quilts.
